Why you should apply:

Calvary Assembly wants *any* and *every* student who is interested to be able to participate in Flower City Work Camp. We believe it is an incredible experience - developing a student's capacity to grow in their knowledge, service, and experience of Christ. Help at church:

We have implemented a program to allow students (or parents) to help clean at church in order to receive a scholarship. This allows for the student to really “own” wanting to go by working for the scholarship. For a full scholarship, a student will work 15 hours; for a half scholarship, a student will work 7.5 hours. Pastor Jordan, Pastor Jonathan, Pastor Bob and our Church Council will decide alternate amounts. We believe this is a unique solution to allow students to be able to join.
